with Stacy Armstrong

Using a systematic approach, students entering first grade will refine and practice handwriting skills and phonemic awareness through multisensory activities. Handwriting skills will include proper pencil grip, letter/number formation, size, and placement of the letter/numbers on the lines. Phonemic awareness will focus on letter sounds, short vowels, blending, and sight word (red word) recognition. Activities will be fun and students will be engaged in a variety of activities throughout the week.

Stacy was a teacher in the 6-9 program at TNSM for 13 years. Currently, she is a private tutor, specializing in reading, handwriting, and math. Stacy uses the Orton-Gillingham method for teaching reading and handwriting.
