





Parent initiates inquiries about TNSM by phone or internet and requests informational brochure.

Parents and children can attend Open House(s) on a Sunday afternoon scheduled in mid October, late January, or late April.

Parent Visit / Observation / Tour is required

- Beginning in October, parent observations are scheduled weekday mornings and last approximately 1 1/2 hours.
- The visit includes in-class observation, a tour of the school, and meeting with the Admissions Director to answer questions and discuss information about TNSM and receipt of a packet of information, including an application.

Parents submit application

Child Visit

- Classroom visits are scheduled for children after an application is submitted.
- "3 and 4-year-olds-to-be" visit individually with a teacher for about 15-30 minutes.
- Kindergarteners-to-be visit for an hour and a half during regular morning class time.
- 6-9 year-olds visit from 10:00-1:00 during a school day.
- 9-12 year-olds visit for the whole school day, 8:15-2:30.
- After the visit, teachers complete an observation form about the child and indicate whether the child has been accepted.
- This form goes to the Admissions Director, who
 reviews applicants with the teachers, advises parents
 of our observations and accepts children according to
 the following criteria.

Enrollment criteria

- Our enrollment criteria are based on determining whether the school can meet the child's needs and on creating balance in the classroom.
- This includes balancing the number of boys/ girls, racial and culture diversity, and the number of children at each age across each 3year span.
- In the event children represent the same general characteristics, the application with the earlier date is given priority.
- Acceptance is need-blind.
- Siblings of current students are given priority and there is a 10% sibling tuition discount.
- Siblings in the same age grouping are placed in separate classes when possible.

Contract

After a child is accepted, a contract is sent.
 This is due back in 2 weeks with a non-refundable deposit.

Orientation Packet

 In the early summer, an orientation packet for the upcoming school year is sent. This includes various forms to be completed, as well as the child's room/teacher assignment, supply list, etc.
